

Clinkscapes' September 2025 Update

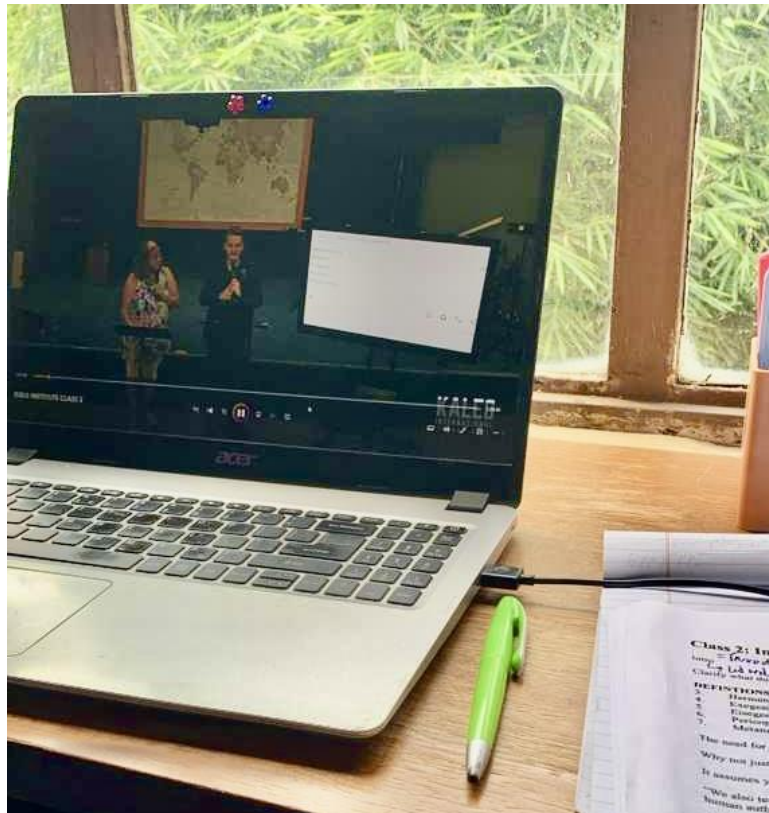
Dear friends and family,

Thank you for your continued prayers for our family as we continue serving here in Mexico. Here are some highlights of the past few months.

Bible Institute: Evan continues to teach in the Bible institute and a new semester has recently started with new students who are hungry to grow in their knowledge of the Scriptures. The classes are also being recorded and taught at other bases with church plants throughout Mexico!

Hospital ministry: Rachel and a team go to the hospital twice every week to give out food and clothes and pray for people. There is great need because many come from other cities and are sleeping on the hospital floors as their loved ones have their hospital stay. It is difficult for them to afford food as they pay hospital bills. Many have received the Gospel and visited our church. One family Rachel has gotten to know has a 5-year-old boy with a brain tumor. It's heartbreaking. Every week they come outside for food and prayer, and last week they joined us at church. God is really ministering to people at the hospital.



Loving families in hard times: We lost a dear sister in Christ last month after her long battle with cancer. This family has been in one of our small groups for the past 2 years. Please pray for comfort for her husband and two teenage boys and that they would have the strength to stay faithful and continue seeking Jesus in this difficult time.

Prison ministry: We were allowed to enter one time to the women's prison and pray for those inside. They were very touched, and we are submitting paperwork to be allowed to do weekly Bible studies and worship services there. Please pray this paperwork goes through soon as there is a lot of spiritual need in the prison.

Brothel ministry: Rachel is bringing mature local believers from our small groups to minister together in the red light district. It has been amazing to see people stretch their faith and learn to share the love of Jesus in the darkest places.

Pastoral Care: Evan continues to head up our base's pastoral care team, and we meet up with our leaders regularly to make sure they are staying healthy in the different areas of their life as they serve.

Disciple making in the home: We strive to create a Christ-centered home and daily teach our five children what it means to love and serve Jesus. We also regularly have people at our house where we counsel and pray for them. Please pray for our home and that our children love Jesus all the days of their lives as they live the challenging and beautiful reality of growing up on the mission field.
