FROM THE PASTOR

PSALM 91 FAITH

Life can often feel overwhelming. With the uncertainties that surround us—from global events to personal struggles—fear has a way of creeping into our hearts. Yet, the Bible consistently reminds us that God has not given us a spirit of fear. One of the most powerful chapters for combating fear is Psalm 91, which reveals how God's protection and love are more than enough to sustain us in tough times.

Here's how you can embrace faith over fear and apply the principles of Psalm 91 to your life:

Dwell in God's Presence ([Psalm 91:1](#))

The first step in overcoming fear is to remain connected to God. Psalm 91 opens with, "Whoever dwells in the shelter of the Most High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty." Dwelling means staying close, intentionally placing yourself in God's presence through prayer, meditation on His Word, and worship.

Speak God's Promises Over Your Fears ([Psalm 91:2](#))

The Psalmist says, "I will say of the Lord, 'He is my refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust.'" There is power in speaking God's promises out loud, especially in moments when fear threatens to consume you. Fear loses its strength when it's confronted by truth.

Trust God's Protection ([Psalm 91:3-6](#))

Psalm 91 reminds us that God will save us from the "fowler's snare" and protect us from "the deadly pestilence." These verses emphasize the full protection that God offers His children. While fear tells us to expect the worst, faith reminds us that God shields us from harm, even when things seem uncertain.

Acknowledge God's Authority Over Every Fear ([Psalm 91:9-10](#))

When you make God your dwelling place, Psalm 91 promises, "no harm will overtake you, no disaster will come near your tent." This doesn't mean life will always be easy, but it reassures us that nothing will happen outside of God's control.

Call on God in Times of Fear ([Psalm 91:14-15](#))

The closing verses of Psalm 91 offer a beautiful reminder: God hears us when we call. Verse 15 says, "He will call on me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble, I will deliver him and honor him." Even in the most fearful moments, God is with us, ready to answer when we call upon Him.

Conclusion

Psalm 91 gives us a roadmap for how to live free from fear. By dwelling in God's presence, speaking His promises, trusting in His protection, acknowledging His authority, and calling on Him in times of trouble, we can experience peace no matter what comes our way. Faith is not the absence of fear; it's choosing to trust God even in the presence of fear.
